

More than 6.7 million visitors passed through its doors. Over a million more people visited the museum last year than in 2012. The director of the museum said he was very happy about the vast number of visitors. <u>He</u> also said online access meant more people decided to visit.</p> <p>The British Museum has many exhibitions about history and culture. It has about 13 million exhibits, some of them are unique artworks from all around the world. Some countries want the museum to return some of <u>them</u>. China wants the museum to return many things the British took from China in the 19th century, and Egypt wants the Rosetta Stone.</p> <p>The museum first opened to the public in 1759. Back then, only 75 people a day visited it. They could look at 71,000 objects, including 40,000 printed books.
